



# Construction Notice

### **NE Dayton Contract 2, Areas 3, 4, & 6 Street and Utility Improvements**

#### **GENERAL**

- Minor construction work will begin in your neighborhood on April 14<sup>th</sup>. The majority of the construction work will begin in about a month. Below are some things to think about before the bulk of construction begins.

#### **ROAD CLOSURE**

- Construction work is scheduled to begin on North Diamond Lake Rd. on April 14<sup>th</sup>. During that time, North Diamond Lake Rd will be closed from Berkshire Ln to about 1500 ft to the west.
- The official detour route is Brockton Ln (Cty Rd 13) and Dayton River Rd (Cty Rd 12).

#### **SCHOOL BUS STOPS**

- There should be no disruption to bus service. If your children ride the bus and there is a change, the bus company will notify you.

#### **GARBAGE SERVICE**

- Your garbage service is being coordinated with the garbage companies. There should be no disruption to your garbage service; we just ask that you write your address on duct tape on the top of your garbage bin so it can be identified.

#### **SEWER AND WATER SERVICE**

- In the coming weeks, you will be given to stakes to identify where you want your sewer and water service placed. It is recommended that you contact a sewer and water contractor soon and have them help to determine the best placed for your service. Additional information will be provided with your service stakes.

#### **TEMPORARY MAILBOXES**

- Temporary mailboxes will be provided for your safety and the safety of the postal carriers. These locations are being determined by the Post Office and you will be notified in advance when this information becomes available.

#### **CENTERPOINT ENERGY GAS MAIN RELOCATION**

- Centerpoint energy will be relocating their gas main in the right of way starting on April 14<sup>th</sup>. Disruption to you will be minimal. The gas company will fill in their holes and restore any areas beyond the right of way. The city's contractor will restore the rest of the construction area when pipe work is complete.
