



# Construction Notice

April 8, 2008

## **CITY PROJECT #000174-06138 NE Dayton Contract 2, Areas 3, 4, & 6 Street and Utility Improvements**

### **ROAD CLOSURE**

- Construction work is scheduled to begin on North Diamond Lake Rd. on April 14<sup>th</sup>. During that time, North Diamond Lake Rd will be closed from Berkshire Ln to about 1500 ft to the west.
- The official detour route is Brockton Ln (Cty Rd 13) and Dayton River Rd (Cty Rd 12). Depending on where construction is located, you will either have to drive east or west on North Diamond to access the detour route.
- Access to your driveway will be provided to you at the end of every day. There may be periods during the day where you will have no access to your driveway; you will be notified in advance so you can move your vehicle.

### **TEMPORARY MAIL BOXES**

- Temporary mail boxes will be installed by Friday April 11<sup>th</sup> on the corner of Berkshire Ln and North Diamond Lake Rd. This location was determined by the USPS. Your address will be written on the mailbox.
- Your mailbox will be removed from its current location and set back on your property out of the way of construction where it will not be damaged. Once construction is completed the contractor will reinstall the mailbox back in its existing location.
- These temporary mailboxes are being provided for your safety and the safety of the postal carriers.

### **SCHOOL BUS STOPS**

- If you have children who ride the school bus, the bus company will notify you of a temporary location that your children will be picked up and dropped off at.

### **GARBAGE SERVICE**

- Your garbage service is being coordinated with the garbage companies. There should be no disruption to your garbage service; we just ask that you write your address on duct tape on the top of your garbage so it can be identified.

### **RIGHT OF WAY**

- The City will be constructing infrastructure within the road right-of-way. Any landscaping and irrigation systems are at risk of being damaged with the construction. Please move anything out of the right-of-way to avoid damage. Any damage to irrigation systems and/or landscaping within the road right-of-way is the responsibility of the property owner.
