

**FINAL PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE SCHEDULED  
NW HENNEPIN COUNTY I-94 SUB-AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY**

Over the next 25 years, significant growth in population and employment is projected in northwest Hennepin County. The Cities of Dayton and Rogers and the Township of Hassan, along with Corcoran and Maple Grove, worked to identify where future roads could be located, where they will connect to regional transportation corridors and where potential new access to I-94 could be located to balance future needs based upon projected growth. The study documented existing conditions and issues, as well as identified potential traffic impacts of future growth on both the current and proposed transportation systems. The result of this effort was the development of a future transportation system plan and recommendations for implementation.

Study partners have scheduled a public open house for **Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup> from 5:00 - 8:00 PM at the Rogers Activity Center** (Second Floor) 21080 141<sup>st</sup> Avenue N. The purpose of this open house is to gain public input on the proposed future transportation system as well as the proposed implementation plan, including specific recommendations on access spacing, potential jurisdictional transfers, and staging of improvements. Representatives from each of the local communities as well as from Mn/DOT, the Metropolitan Council and Hennepin County will be available at the open house to collect public input and answer questions.
